



Broader Public Sector Procurement Directive

Purpose

- To ensure that publicly funded goods and services, including construction, consulting services, and information technology are acquired by Broader Public Sector (BPS) organizations through a process that is open, fair, and transparent
- To outline responsibilities of BPS organizations throughout each stage of the procurement process; and
- To ensure that procurement processes are managed consistently

Principles

Accountability – organization must be accountable for the results of their procurement decisions and appropriateness of the processes.

Transparency – organizations must be transparent to all stakeholders. Wherever possible, stakeholders must have equal access to information on procurement opportunities, processes and results.

Value for Money – organizations must maximize the value they receive from the use of public funds. A value for money approach aims to deliver goods and services at the optimum total life-cycle cost.

Quality Service Delivery – front line services provided by organizations must receive the right product, at the right time and in the right place.

Process Standardization – standardized processes remove inefficiencies and create a level playing field.
